### British Literature Classics (9th through 10th grade)

**Course Description:** In this course, students will study different British literary classics from a variety of authors including William Shakespeare, Jane Austen, and Charles Dickens. Analytical paragraphs, essays, and research papers will be written on the assigned readings. Students will be expected to read the assigned texts, write papers, research, and document information from credible secondary sources.

Internet access for research, an email address to communicate with the instructor, and Google Drive account is required to share information and papers between the instructor and students.

Students must have access at home to a computer/laptop/iPad and the internet for this class. Students are required to bring a laptop/iPad to class. Grades and assignments will be shared through Edmodo.
