Introduction to Literary Analysis (8th through 9th grade)

Course Description: In this course, students will be reading works from classic literature. They will also write literary analysis paragraphs and research essays based on the literature read. Outside reading, writing, and sharing of papers with the instructor will be expected weekly. Internet access for research, a Shelby County library card, and an email address, and a Google Drive account is required to communicate with the instructor. Students must have access at home to a computer/laptop/iPad and the internet for this class. Students are required to bring a laptop/iPad to class. Edmodo will be used by the instructor for accessing assignments as well as grading.
