Eastern Hemisphere Studies for Middle School (6th through 8th grade)

Course Description: Eastern Hemisphere Studies is a cultural study focusing on several lesser-studied countries, regions and continents. This study of non-Western cultures focuses primarily on people groups who comprise two-thirds of the world's population. These nations are, for the most part, unreached by the Gospel. We desire that your students develop a heart for those who do not know Christ and especially for those whose governments limit the spread of the Gospel.

Sonlight is a literature-based curriculum that breaks up assignments into Bible, History & Geography, Read-Alouds, and Readers. When planning for the school year, you should choose from the following options:

Option 1: Mrs. Holland will be covering only the History & Geography portion of the assignments listed in the Sonlight Core F instructor's guide, along with some of the Read-Alouds. She will make assignments and provide a required book list at a later date. (If you wish to complete only the History & Geography portion, it will not be necessary to purchase the entire Sonlight Core F instructor's guide.) This option results in a credit for history.

Option 2: Much of the richness of Sonlight Core F lies in its Bible, Read-Alouds, and Readers assignments. Therefore, you are encouraged to purchase the Sonlight Core F instructor's guide and to complete the Bible, Read-Alouds, and Readers assignments on your own. These components will not be covered in class. This option results in a credit for Bible, a credit for history, and a partial credit in language arts (you will need to add grammar and writing).

Prerequisite: If your child cannot, at a minimum, read at a 6th grade reading level, please contact the instructor before registering.

Instructor: Mrs. Stacey Holland graduated from The University of Montevallo in 1993, with a B.S. in Speech and Language Pathology. She practiced in home health for a year and then moved out of state upon marrying Jay Holland. They have been married for 24 years. In 1999 she received a Masters of Elementary Education from The University of Montevallo. Stacey taught K4 for three years at Hoover Church of Christ Day School. This will be her fourth year teaching at Chelsea Tutorials.
