Forensic Science (10th through 12th grade)

Course Description: This is a high school science course worth one high school science credit (including a lab) or can be taken as an elective. We will use a combination of physical science, chemistry and biology in our exploration of forensics. Your student will gain a basic understanding of the history of Forensics, services provided by crime labs and the functions of a forensic scientist. Your student will also be able to understand the collecting and analyzing of physical evidence as it relates to soil, firearms, ammunition, hairs, (some) body fluids, drugs, drug paraphernalia, bodies and DNA. There may be some sensitive topics like crime scene situations, violence analysis, drug use and autopsy. The sensitive topics will be handled in an age appropriate and delicate manner. The instructor will strive to link Forensics with the Biblical aspect of justice (Isaiah 1:17, Micah 6:8, Romans 12:19, Psalm 106:3, Matthew 5:38-39) and submission to the authorities as prescribed in Romans 13:1-14.

Instructor: Mrs. Stacey Holland graduated from The University of Montevallo in 1993, with a B.S. in Speech and Language Pathology. She practiced in home health for a year and then moved out of state upon marrying Jay Holland. They have been married for 24 years. In 1999 she received a Masters of Elementary Education from The University of Montevallo. Stacey taught K4 for three years at Hoover Church of Christ Day School. She and Jay have four children ranging in ages from 19-11. Their oldest has High Functioning Autism Spectrum Disorder which led her to begin homeschooling. She has homeschooled for six years.
