General Science 1 for Middle School (6th through 8th grade)

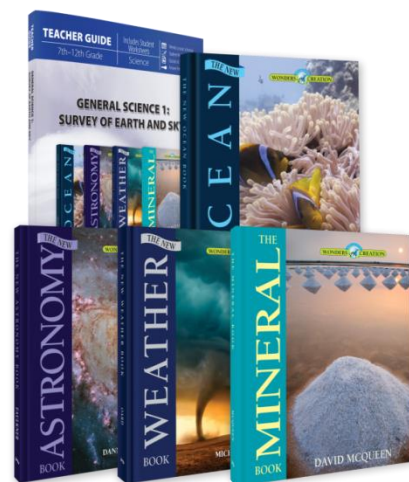
