American Literature Classics (9th through 12th grade)

Course Description: In this course, students will study classic American literature. The material chosen for this class deals with **mature themes** that will be discussed in the classroom from a Biblical Worldview. Paragraphs, essays, and research papers will be written on the assigned readings. Outside reading, writing, research, and sharing of papers will be required each week. Internet access for research, an email address to communicate with the instructor, and Google Drive account are required to share information and papers between the instructor and students. The instructor uses Google Classroom for assignments, grade book, and class information. Upon completion of this class, students will have a clear knowledge of how to write a literary analysis essay, research secondary sources, annotate literary sources, and an understanding of some great American classics.

Instructor: Mrs. Beth Moore. Mrs. Moore holds a B.A. in English from Samford University with a minor in history. She has an M.A. in English from the University of Alabama at Birmingham (UAB). She has seven years of teaching experience at Pelham High School where she taught General English, Advanced English, and AP Prep English classes. 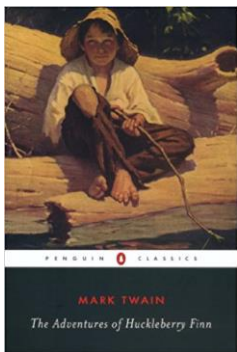
Tuition and Fees:

Registration Fee: \$25 nonrefundable payable to Beth Moore.

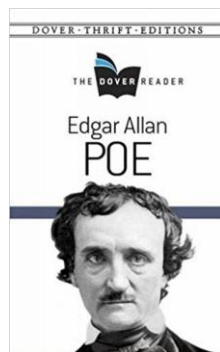
Tuition: \$185 per semester payable to Beth Moore

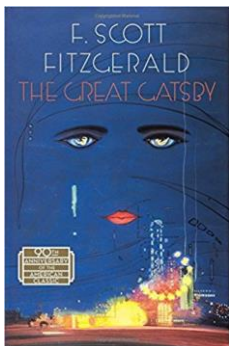
Class Minimum: If a class minimum of 5 students is not reached, class may be cancelled. A maximum of 12 students will be accepted.



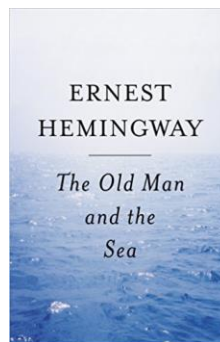
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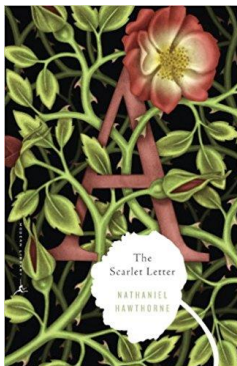
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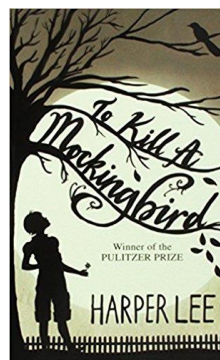
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
