U.S. History in One Year for Middle School (6th through 8th grade)

Course Description: U.S. History for Middle School: From the discovery of America to modern times, we will explore the rich history of this great nation. Students will learn American History from a conservative, Christian point of view. Students will gain an understanding of how God's perfect timing led us from discovery to colonization, through revolutionary times, wars, and industrial development.
