### U.S. History – Part 1 (9th through 12th grade)

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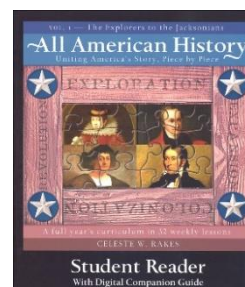
**Course Description:** U.S. History Part 1 for High School: From European Exploration to early nineteenth century, we will explore the early history of this great nation. Students will learn American History from a conservative, Christian point of view. Students will gain an understanding of how God's perfect timing led us from discovery to colonization, through revolutionary times, wars, and industrial development. American history is not perfect nor without mistakes, but students will see how we can learn from mistakes and use God's guidance to prevent future mistakes. We will use maps to help create a deeper understanding of where certain events occurred. Extra research will be used at times to develop skills needed for higher level learning and critical thinking. The overall goal is for the students to learn a patriotic and positive overview of our early history while developing an understanding of God's providence through it all.
